Education notes

I do not have any degrees and have only graduated from the 9 years of Finnish primary and lower scondary education. Here, I try to briefly explain why.

In 2009, my mental health took a huge downturn. I was diagnosed with bipolar disorder and autism. I was barely able to keep up with school, but with perseverance ended up graduating on time with relatively good grades.

I went to a gymnasium normally, but had to drop out very soon due to these issues. After some years not being in any education, I started gymnasium again at Tampereen Aikuislukio.

At this point I was still recovering and progress was slow, but was able to go through all courses I attempted, and only had a couple of mandatory courses left before I could graduate.

Then, in 2019, I got employed as a part-time expert salesman. Because of my financial situation, employment took priority over education and my school progress stopped. But the employment also helped me recover even more, and these days my mental health is doing very well.

Despite these shortcomings in my education, I have never just stood still without doing anything productive. Every step of the way, I was also improving myself and my skills in various areas, most notably software development and music production.
